We are a bi-national organization with a multi-year mandate to promote a cohesive vision of the U.S.-Canada border based on the principles of efficiency, safety, and security, supported by continuous improvements in technology, processes, facilities, and innovation.¹

Our membership is widely diverse and cross-sectoral, covering all modes of transportation (air, land, maritime), cargo and logistics, the tourism sector, and the academic research community. In 2019, Beyond Preclearance members recognized the need to address a broad, long-term mandate and formed the Future Borders Coalition.
